Health

- ✓ Primary health care facilities with UNOPS



- ✓ To build 14-18 facilities in 7 regions and states across Myanmar.
- ✓ To hand over to Ministry of Health
- ✓ OML first private entity with dedicated fund with UNOPS for project delivery in Myanmar

Total expenditure : USD 3.1 million

- ✓ Mobile health clinics with PACT Myanmar



- ✓ Since 2015, OML has funded 2 Mobile Health Clinics in Madaya.
- ✓ Fully funded by OM: Free health care service + lab test
- ✓ Improving the doctor/population ratio by 250%

Total expenditure : MMK 1,370,138,120

- ✓ Clean water initiatives with Red Cross Myanmar



- ✓ Emergency aid and rehabilitation in the flood affected areas
- ✓ Sustainable development by extending the project for another 14 wells in flood and drought prone regions.

Total expenditure : MMK 200 mil

Education

- ✓ English training with University of Oxford for 700 students



- Have conducted successful English language training program in consultation with University of Yangon for 700 students.
- Considering initiatives to offer capacity building, connectivity and content to re-invigorate higher education in Myanmar
- **Total expenditure : USD 42,000**

- ✓ English training and test for 800 teachers by the British council



- Enabled 800 local public school teachers to be trained by the British Council.
- The English language test also administered by British Council
- **Total expenditure : USD 120,000**

- ✓ Connecting libraries across Myanmar with Beyond access



DAW KHIN KYI
FOUNDATION

- Since 2015, OM provided 187 tablets, 3G wifi routers + data usage to 55 libraries.
- 3.7K users/ month improve their digital skills, 18K people accessed the internet for the first time, 84K people utilized tablets.
- Planning expansion to an additional 35 libraries, reaching a total of 90 libraries in 11 States and Divisions.
- **Total expenditure : USD 63,483**
